

# Regulation

Please observe the following rules strictly during your stay.




All rooms and buildings are **NON-SMOKING!!**

We have ashtrays in front of the entrance.

Please do not use a red bucket in front of house for the fire extinguisher as an ashtray.



Please do not throw cigarette butts on the street. If you break these rules, you need to pay a fine even after your check-out.



In this traditional building, noise can be heard **VERY EASILY!**



Please keep noise down and be quiet especially at night and morning!

If you make a lot of noise even if we warn you and we get a claim from the other guests, we may ask you to leave the house.



If you check-out in early morning or are going in and out at midnight, please move your luggage and suitcase **carefully and slowly** otherwise it might be a noise trouble for other guests and neighbors.



If someone who's not on the registration card stayed without notice, we'll alert it to police and charge you a penalty.

Please let us know for sure.

Please do not ask our cleaning staff because they don't understand both **Japanese and English**, and it may cause some miscommunication.



If any damage occurs to the hostel property, we may ask you to cover the expense of its repair or replacement. And please do not bring hostel property out or bring chair, hair dryer in common space into your room.



If you lose the room key, we need to ask you to pay **¥1000** for repairing it.



The door, which you cannot lock with the key we gave you, is common use. Please **DO NOT** lock!

Please take thought for our neighbors & other guests



Please **do not** hang out on the street and sit inside the space of neighbors' house.



Please **do not** making a lot of noise.



Please **do not** spit on the street.



Please **make sure to put your garbage** in the trash box **inside your building**

If you park the bicycles in front of the neighbors' house or on the street, it will be troublesome, we immediately take them away.



If you park the bicycles without a permission on the street, and they are taken away by Kyoto city council, we **do not take any responsibility**.
